Organize list of essays and outline or re-write. Keep your grades up Meet with college reps that come on campus Consider applying for Early Decision or Early Action, but KNOW what you are applying for. 	<p>October</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Keep track of deadlines (Excel spreadsheet) Take ACT and/or SAT Plan college visits and interviews (don't forget "thank you" letters) Check for local college fairs and visits Start checking the Career Center for scholarships. Begin asking teachers, employers, counselors ect. For letters of recommendation for scholarships and colleges. Begin to send applications 	<p>November</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Attend Boise College Fair Send Early Decision or Early Action applications. Submit secondary school/counselor evaluation forms as soon as they arrive Keep organizer up to date! Send applications 	<p>December</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Check out FAFSA website for financial aid information (www.fafsa.ed.gov) Make sure you & a parent both have a PIN number for FAFSA – This MUST be done, regardless of parents financial situation, if you are going to qualify for ANY scholarships at the college level. Take ACT or SAT Follow-up with letters of recommendation (supply addressed envelopes and stamps) Don't forget to write "Thank You" letters to those who wrote your letters of rec. 	<p>January</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Start filling out FAFSA as of January 1st. File an "estimated" FAFSA using the most current tax documents you have, you can always update after you have last year's taxes done. Send end of semester transcripts to colleges.
<p>February</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take ACT/SAT again Make sure colleges received your submitted FAFSA by FEBRUARY 15th Make sure application materials have been received by colleges 	<p>March</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Look for college acceptance letters to start appearing Check on AP credits Review FAFSA and update if necessary 	<p>April</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you have not heard from colleges, call the admission departments Make a decision on where you will attend Write response letters to colleges. If on a waiting list send additional info (new test scores, letter 	<p>May</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take AP exams Fill out housing forms Register for classes, make sure you have talked with an advisor first.
