## TOEFL Information

The best way to prepare for any college entrance test is to do your very best at all times. This means taking challenging courses and studying hard. You may take the tests as many times as you wish, but it is wise to at least take one in the spring of your junior year. The results will tell you if you need to do some extra studying in any particular area. (The PSAT in October at EHS is also a good practice test for 9th – 11th grade students.)

Get a good night's sleep and eat a nutritious breakfast prior to taking a test. Arrive a few minutes early, bring a calculator, picture ID and a couple of pencils. In addition to the ideas listed below, you can find books, practice tests, software, etc. to purchase in local stores. Private individuals in the community offer tutoring to students individually, or in small groups, as well. The cost for this type of help varies. The Career Center at Eagle High also has a few materials that can be checked out.
